

## PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT for GREENWAY JOINT RECREATION ASSOCIATION

As a Greenway Joint Recreation Association Parent, I hereby pledge that I will:

- Provide Support, care and encouragement for each child participating in the Greenway Joint Recreations Association.
- Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support at all times.
- Remember that children participate to have fun, and that the game is for youth, not adult
- Treat officials, opposing coaches and players with respect and dignity, and instruct my child to do the same.
- Model grace, dignity and composure regardless of the outcome of the game.
- Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parents such as taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profanity
- Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning
- Not use of profanity to any player, coach, parent or official, as it will not be tolerated.
- Any physical altercations involving spectators, coaches, players, parents, umpires or GJRA staff will result in immediate removal and expulsion of the program.
- Refrain from bringing alcohol or using alcohol, drugs, tobacco, etc at or near any game, practice, on school property, or opposing team venues.
- Refrain from all manners of personal abuse and harassment of others, whether verbal, physical, emotional or sexual. This includes all social media outlets.
- Report any conduct that violates this code or adversely affects the positive, kid friendly environment the Greenway Joint Recreation Association strives for.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the above rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action levied by the Greenway Joint Recreation Association, that could include, but not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Parental game and/or practice suspension
- Parental Suspension for season
- Parental Removal from all league activities

The Greenway Joint Recreation Association retains sole authority to determine what, if any, disciplinary action is appropriate for the conduct infraction.
